INFORMATION LETTER

On behalf of Musicfest Canada, our presenting sponsors, and in particular the Honour Ensemble Team, we welcome you to the 2014 “The Nationals”. You are a member of a 50+ piece ensemble of Canada’s most outstanding young musicians. We anticipate that you will be performing for over 1,000 participants attending the National Festival in Richmond.

The following information will help make this a memorable event in your musical career. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact us.

REGISTRATION FORM AND LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING

Your application has been accepted and by now you should have received an e-mail welcoming you to the ensemble and encouraging you to register at your earliest convenience.

If you have not done so already, please complete the online Registration Form. Most of the information was already input as part of your application, but we now need a few more details such as your travel and accommodations information.

To register:

- a) Visit the Musicfest Canada website at www.musicfest.ca
- b) Select “Login” found on the red navigation bar
- c) Select the “Honour Ensemble Member/Applicant” link
- d) Enter your e-mail address and password
- e) Complete and/or edit your Registration Form. Make sure you complete all fields
- f) Click on the “Save” button

You can access this form any time and add or change information such as airplane flight information as it becomes available.

SPONSORSHIP/REGISTRATION FEE

There is **NO** participation/registration fee to perform with any of the honour bands. Musicfest Canada and their sponsors underwrite the operating costs associated with the bands. Those costs include conductors, music, rehearsal space, clinicians, guest soloists, musical equipment, technical staff and concert venue. The objective is to provide a special educational opportunity for Canada's most outstanding young musicians.

PARTICIPANT ACCOMMODATIONS

Accommodations for members, directors, and staff have been arranged at the Marriott Vancouver Airport Hotel, 7571 Westminster Highway, Richmond (BC), V6X 1A3, 604-276-2112. It is a 4.5 Star Hotel with all of the amenities and services one would expect at a luxury property. Accommodations are 2 people per room.

Members of the honour ensembles are encouraged to stay at the Marriott, but **ARE NOT** required to do so. Some members of the ensemble will be traveling with their own school bands and others are local students who already have accommodations in the area. For those wishing to stay at the Marriott, the cost is \$450.00 for the week and the Cheques should be made payable to Musicfest Canada and mailed to 311 Main St., Exeter, ON N0M 1S7 by **April 20, 2014**.

Musicfest is subsidizing the costs to have participants reside close to the rehearsal locations. The Marriott has limited capacity so they are limited to members of the honour ensembles and can only be booked through the Musicfest Canada office. These arrangements are limited to six (6) nights only. If you would like a specific room-mate, indicate the other name when you register.

If you require accommodations, please indicate so on your online registration record by April 10, 2014 so we can make the proper arrangements. If you have a preference for the person sharing the room, please indicate that on your online registration.

Check In: Sunday, May 11, 4:00 – 7:00 p.m.

Check Out: Saturday May 17, 11:00 a.m.

RELATIVE/FRIEND ACCOMMODATIONS

If you have relatives from out-of-town that plan to stay in Richmond and would like to access the Musicfest convention rate, please contact Michelle Hern at Ellison Travel and Tours, 1-800-265-7024. These rooms are limited to parents, relatives and friends of participants of the Honour Bands.

CURFEWS

Because of the age of the majority of the band, no curfews will be imposed. It is expected that all ensemble members will use their common sense in this regard. The schedule is heavy and it is vitally important that all members remain in the best of mental and physical health by maintaining a healthy rest schedule. **HOWEVER**, we recognize that we do have some members

who are below the age of consent. We would be pleased to conduct an evening check in/curfew with any members so indicating on the registration form.

SOCIAL EVENTS

Musicfest has sponsored a number of musical and non-musical social events for the honour ensemble participants. These events include concert presented by Musicfest, and will be announced at the welcome reception on Sunday evening (see below). All honour ensemble members are invited and there is no charge.

WELCOME RECEPTION

The welcoming PIZZA PARTY/RECEPTION will take place Sunday, May 11 at 7:00 PM. You will be able to meet all of the Honour Ensemble Team and fellow ensemble members. A short “read-through” rehearsal will follow the reception. Both events will take place at the Marriott Hotel.

FOOD

The schedule allows for a reasonable start time each day, along with lunch and supper breaks (or free time). Each member is responsible for his or her own breakfast, lunch, and dinner. No group meals have been scheduled beyond the opening and closing receptions. Refreshments will be available at all rehearsals. Fast food and restaurants are within easy walking distance.

TRANSPORTATION TO RICHMOND

Transportation to and from Richmond is the responsibility of each individual musician. Ellison Travel and Tours can make arrangements either by air, train or bus and they will find the lowest possible price. TRAVELING BY AIR

Please ensure you complete the “Transportation” section of the online Registration Form. It is important that we have your flight information. Unless there are circumstances beyond our control, we will pick you up and deliver you back to your terminal. The Richmond Festival is located approximately 10 minutes from the Vancouver International Airport (except at rush hour).

When you arrive, remain at the baggage carousel. Unless there is a traffic delay you will be met promptly by Musicfest staff that will be easily identifiable either wearing a Musicfest T-shirt and/or carrying a Musicfest sign. If your plane arrives early, please wait in the terminal at the baggage carousel. We will also be tracking your flight on Flytecomm.

If you are delayed, or no one picks you up within 20 minutes of the flight times you recorded on your registration form, please call us. The head of transportation is Thaddeus Howard and his

cell is 702-301-8939. Finally, make sure that your cel number, if you have one, is recorded on your registration form.

PARKING

For those staying at the Marriott or driving in each day, paid parking is available. Parking costs vary depending on which lot you select and the proximity to the Hotels. There is free parking a few blocks away at the Richmond Centre.

TRANSPORTATION TO ORGANIZED EVENTS

Appropriate transportation will be provided by Musicfest Canada to all scheduled group events. Everyone will be notified of the shuttle schedules. Anyone missing the departure deadline will be responsible to get themselves to the location.

All other travel arrangements while in Richmond are the responsibility of each ensemble member.

REHEARSALS

Canadian Wind Ensemble rehearsals will take place at the Marriott Vancouver Airport Hotel, 7571 Westminster Highway, Richmond (BC), V6X 1A3, 604-276-2112

MUSICFEST CANADA

All honour ensemble participants will receive Musicfest Canada accreditation (participant passes) and will have access to all clinics, workshops and concert performances from May 12-16. Additional registration to attend events is not required. As concert seating can be limited, performers must request seats in advance.

SCHOLARSHIPS

All honour ensemble participants are automatically considered for scholarships providing they applied for the "Band and Scholarships" on the on line registration. If you are not sure, please go on line and check your "scholarship status." **NO SEPARATE RECORDING FROM YOUR ORIGINAL SUBMISSION IS/WAS REQUIRED.** The scholarships include those sponsored by Wick, Dream, Rico, MIAC and various colleges, universities and camps. FREE TIME

You may use this time to practice, attend Musicfest events or tour Richmond.

SCHEDULE

The preliminary schedule is attached and will be posted on the Musicfest Canada website. Minor modifications may be required in order to fine-tune it, but for the most part, it is set. You will be provided with a final schedule upon arrival in Richmond. It will be distributed at the welcome reception at 7:00 p.m. on Sunday, May 12.

ATTENDANCE AT REHEARSALS

Attendance at all rehearsals and dress rehearsals is mandatory. All ensemble members must be present and ready to play at the scheduled time. If you have a performance conflict with your school band, you must inform one of the Honour Team members well in advance.

ENSEMBLE MANAGERS

The Ensemble Managers have extensive experience with bands and tours. They will represent Musicfest Canada and will act as the onsite managers for the band. They will be staying at the Marriott Hotel and are well equipped to handle any emergencies, special requests and will coordinate transportation. A contact cell phone number will be provided when you arrive in Richmond. Their decisions regarding the management aspect of the ensemble will be final.

SECTIONALS

In addition to the full ensemble rehearsals, Tuesday morning has been set aside for sectional rehearsals with the Canadian Wind Orchestra. Sectionals are mandatory.

DRESS CODE

For the concert at Fraserview Mennonite Church, members of the Canadian Wind Orchestra will be expected to dress in regular concert attire. Gentlemen and ladies must wear appropriate concert clothing. Black dress pants, black shoes, white shirt, black dress jacket and a black bow tie for the gentlemen (tuxedo appreciated). Black dress pants or mid-calf to ankle length skirt with full bodice (not backless), long sleeves, black hose, black shoes for the ladies.

Any questions regarding appropriateness of dress should be addressed to one of the Ensemble Managers. Limited dressing rooms facilities will be available at Fraserview Mennonite Brethren Church.

GUEST TICKETS TO THE CONCERT

The Gala Concerts for the Canadian Wind Orchestra, Conn-Selmer Centerstage Jazz Band, Ellison Canadian Honour Choir and the Canadian String Orchestra will be held on Friday, May 16 at the Fraserview and we anticipate a capacity crowd. The Conn-Selmer Centerstage Jazz Band will perform at 5:30 and the Denis Wick Canadian Wind Orchestra at 8:30.

Musicfest is not allowed to sell tickets to that, or any other concert. All concerts are “for participants only” and only registered participants will be seated. Everyone at Musicfest realizes that many of you have friends and or relatives that will want to attend. The only way that can happen is for them to “register” as participants. That means that as registered participants they will be able to attend all Musicfest events, including workshops and admission to the evening concerts.

There will be a very limited number of these passes available. Musicfest is planning to hold back 100 seats (approximately 2 per ensemble member). Some ensemble members will not use their allotted seats, so there will be a few extras. However, in the end, the limit will be 100 for the whole band. The cost will be \$25.00 to “register.” To book seats, please do so on your online record and e-mail administration@musicfest.ca with your “wish list.” Musicfest will confirm the actual number in late in April. If you do not need any seats, please do not make a request. We will collect payments and distribute tickets when you arrive in Richmond.

CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES

All ensemble members must abide by the laws and regulations of the Province of British Columbia and the Country of Canada, including but not limited to the smoking of tobacco products; the consumption purchase and distribution of alcohol; and the use and/or distribution of illegal narcotics. In addition, no alcohol or tobacco will be permitted at any scheduled events or at any event at the Musicfest Canada festival site.
