Bronze Awards • Médailles de Bronze

Honour Awards

MusicFest Canada may, at their discretion, select an individual from each ensemble performing at MusicFest to receive the MusicFest Honour Award. The award consists of a commemorative plaque.

Educational and institutional awards are subject to the dates as set forth by the respective institution.
