2027 YOUNG CONDUCTOR RESIDENCY

The Young Conductor Residency (YCR) is an intensive training and observing program designed for undergraduate music students who have a passion to learn more about the art and craft of ensemble leadership. Entrance is by audition. If accepted to participate, YCR participants will: observe all JLNHB rehearsals; attend guest lectures by leading professionals in the field; study all works to be performed alongside the Artistic Directors; lead one of the works performed by the JLNHB in a session recorded for reflective study; and receive ongoing coaching from both Gillian MacKay (University of Toronto) and Mark Hopkins (Acadia University).
