**NATIONAL ARTS CENTRE AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING STRING PLAYER:** The National Arts Centre, in conjunction with the Festival, will provide a cash scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 to a most outstanding individual string player. The cash award will be presented following the Festival and must be used before December 31, 2008 by individuals meeting the criteria as set out by the Board of Directors. The decision of the Festival will be final in all cases.

**NATIONAL ARTS CENTRE AWARD FOR OUTSTANDING BRASS PLAYER:** The National Arts Centre, in conjunction with the Festival, will provide a cash scholarship in the amount of \$1,000.00 to a most outstanding individual brass player. The cash award will be presented following the Festival and must be used before December 31, 2008 by individuals meeting the criteria as set out by the Board of Directors. The decision of the Festival will be final in all cases.

**STEVE'S MUSIC OUTSTANDING GUITARIST AWARD:** Steve's Music, in conjunction with the Festival, will provide a cash scholarship in the amount of \$500.00 to a most outstanding individual guitarist. The cash award will be presented following the Festival and must be used before December 31, 2008 by individuals meeting the criteria as set out by the Board of Directors. **CODA MAGAZINE LEAD TRUMPET SCHOLARSHIP:** CODA Magazine, in conjunction with MusicFest Canada, will provide a \$500.00 cash scholarship to the most outstanding lead trumpet player at MusicFest Canada. The cash award will be presented following the Festival and must be used before December 31, 2008 by an individual meeting the criteria as set out by the Board of Directors.
